Particularly with ruminants who have a large gut fill and gravity affects the pressure on the wound. Also, you can't tell a sheep it should not walk around too much or stretch its wound post surgery! When you look at the number of abdominal surgeries we have performed on sheep and goats (100's) there have only been a few animals with hernias occurring post surgery (less than 5 as far as I can recall). The occurrence is unfortunate, but not unrealistic.
