Official Information Act Request – Livestock Feeding Trial

As advised in their letter to you on 29 April 2025, the Environmental Protection Authority (EPA) has transferred to AgResearch questions 2-6 of your official information request to the EPA which you made on 28 March 2025. I write to you to respond to those questions, which are set out below with the corresponding answers:

2. How many animals are involved in the trial?

24 sheep were involved in the feeding trial – 12 eating HME ryegrass and 12 eating Null ryegrass (no HME-associated genes/traits)

3. The duration of the trials?

There was only one trial, which ran for 11 days - 7 days in pens + 2 days in crates for acclimation + 2 days in respiration chambers for gas emission measurements.

4. Are they contained in a secure facility?

The sheep were fed in a facility only accessible to suitably trained AgResearch staff. The grass had been processed and rendered non-viable prior to being fed to the sheep, and the sheep have not entered the petfood or human food chain.

5. Will it be approved as a field trial?

AgResearch has not submitted any applications for HME ryegrass to be used in a field trial. Any use of HME ryegrass in a field trial would require the approval of the regulator.

6. When will the required Annual Reports of the trial be available for public view?

Annual reporting for this research is not required. A summary of the findings from the trial are expected to be made publicly available by early-May 2025. A manuscript for peer-reviewed publication in a scientific journal is also currently being prepared.

The balance of the questions you asked in your request (1, 7 and 8) will be addressed by the EPA directly with you.
